Each year at 11 am on the 11th day of the 11th month, which is the date of the Armistice of the First World War in 1918, a wreath is laid on our War Memorial in Church Lane. This is to commemorate those men from Great and Little Cransley who gave their lives in the First and Second World Wars. The wreath is laid each year by Councillor Appleby, Vice Chairman of Great Cransley Parish Council and a former Serviceman of the Royal Tank Regiment, representing the residents of our village and those who have connections with it, remembering the great debt we owe to these young men.
